The South Australian Potato Industry Scholarship gives people in the potato industry the opportunity to access **a scholarship of up to \$10,000** to support professional development or training.



About

The South Australian Potato Industry Trust (SAPIT) was established in 1987 from the formerly grower funded South Australian Potato Board. The Trust supports research and development into all aspects of the farming and sale of potatoes and potato products and the general development and promotion of the potato industry in South Australia.

SAPIT recognises the importance of capacity building and skill development so established the Potato Industry Scholarship.

The scholarship aims to encourage involvement, support professional development and increase skills in the potato industry.

Professional development and training areas

Applicants can select professional development or training which build skills in:

- Leadership
- Agronomy
- Logistics
- Food processing or innovation
- Management or business.

Applicants must describe how building skills in these areas will increase their ability to positively contribute to the potato industry.

Eligibility

Open to individuals directly involved in the production phase, with a minimum of one year working in the potato industry.

Applicants must be working or studying in South Australia and must be an Australian citizen / permanent resident.

Investment is not retrospective and must be for a future purpose.

Selection Criteria

Applicants must complete the attached form, and demonstrate:

- Their commitment and interest in the potato industry.
- Academic excellence or relevant professional experience.
- Potential for positive impact on the industry.

Conditions of entry:

- Applicants must provide a clear budget for the professional development / training opportunity including travel / accommodation. SAPIT will contribute a maximum of up to \$10,000 (ex GST).
- Training / professional development must be completed in the 24/25 financial year.
- Applicants must provide a copy of their resume including a profile photo and the details of two referees.
- Following the training, participants must write a report detailing how they used the scholarship, and the benefits to the potato industry (estimate 2-3 pages with photos or a small video which provides evidence of participation).
- Applicants must be currently working in the SA potato industry and are over 18 years of age.
